


RED GUIDE POSTS

Working together in weed management

Identifying biosecurity risks on our roadsides

Red guide posts are being installed throughout NSW to identify biosecurity risks along our roadsides

Why?

- To identify known locations of priority weeds
- To alert machinery operators of the site
- To encourage liaison with local council weed officers on each site's requirements
- To prevent further spread of priority weeds

What can you do?



Avoid driving through infestations

Inspect and clean clothing and equipment

Report suspicious plants

Biosecurity is a shared responsibility

Any person who deals with biosecurity matter or a carrier has a biosecurity duty to ensure that as far as is reasonably practicable, the biosecurity risk is prevented, eliminated, minimised and managed.
